



The cold winter months pose special challenges for classic cars.

By following the recommendations in our checklist, you can ensure that your classic car survives the winter unscathed and is ready to go again in the spring.

	Storage location: Dry, well ventilated, and frost-free—ideally in a garage.
	Cleaning: Wash and polish thoroughly to prevent rust and corrosion. Additional work: Rubber care
	Check operating fluids: Change the engine oil, check the coolant, brake fluid, and other fluids, and maintain them at regular intervals.
	Fuel: Fill tank completely (if not a plastic tank)
	Battery: Maintain the battery and check it regularly.
	Tire pressure: Increase to the maximum recommended pressure.
	Prevent flat spots: with tire protectors.
	Ventilation: Open windows slightly to prevent moisture build-up.
	Cover: Use a breathable vehicle cover.
	Extra theft protection: With a GPS tracker
	No more corrosion: cloth plugs in the exhaust pipe.
	Release brakes: Do not apply the handbrake, engage a gear, use wheel chocks on steep slopes.
